

Taking commissions from Stormdragonblue

How I work:

As I liked the way I did my badge commissions before going to the US and AC2010 I wanted to extend this idea towards normal commission taking. The idea behind this is that you will be added to a list. This list has no limit count but of course based on where you are in it you will obviously be waiting longer or shorter.

Once I reach your name I will contact you. You will give me your commission idea and if need be I'll discuss it with you. Once I have finished it and you have paid I will move on to the next person in that line and repeat the process.

This entire idea allows me to start and stop with commission lists at will. Due to my work schedule and generally what I do at home my time I can spend on commissions can vary quite wildly. This flexible pick up, drop, then pick up again list idea makes me be far more flexible. In the end I will feel happier when I can get to the list again and you are ensured of a spot so you don't need to stalk my journal in the hopes of grabbing a slot.

To get a slot reply to the journal I posted this commission information into, send me a not or e-mail me. All info can be found on my FA page.

VERY IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER: Being on this list does **not** give you the right to bug the hell out of me regarding when I will start on your commission. As long as no payment has been made and we agreed fully on your commission idea I feel in no way obliged to keep you up to date on your commission status. Your turn is when it is your turn and I contact you. This can be in a hour, a day, a week or months depending on how fast I work trough the list and your position in it. If you do annoy me with asking over and over I'll remove you out of the list. Simple as that.

How I prefer to work on commissions:

- References are always highly appreciated! The more the better.
- I prefer to have commissions that are open to a extend. This means that if you give me a 3000 word count commission idea that goes even into the smallest of small details I'll likely refuse to take it. Those kinds of commissions feel to me like work and that is not what I want. I do this in my spare time for fun after all.
- Keep the English somewhat simple in descriptions. I've had commissions where I had to Google up words every odd sentence. My English goes quite far but not all the way so please do take it somewhat into consideration.

- Every commission has a base count of 2 people. If more then 2 it's \$10 extra a person.
- Digital images can also be bought as print on request (coming very soon, printer for this underway!). A extra \$15 for A4 size max. \$20 for A3 size max. Shipping included in price.
- I can also laminate your commission on request. Price for this is \$5 a page. I cannot laminate images bigger then A4 size so if you wanted a A3 print laminated I can unfortunately not do this.

- For the time being I will not take comic or very large sequence commissions.
